health and quality of life for women of color and their families. The \$10,000 IWES received will support their Sexual and Reproductive Health & Justice Initiative and their Sexual and Reproductive Health Advocacy Project.



Just Economics of Asheville, NC received \$5,000 for their Living Wage Employer Certification Program and their Voices of Economic Justice Leadership Development Program for low-wage workers. 80 employers have already been certified through the Living Wage Program. Their Leadership Development Program, offered in English, Spanish and Russian, is breaking ground in Western North Carolina.



SisterLove of Atlanta, GA is on a mission to eradicate the adverse impact of HIV/AIDS and other reproductive health challenges upon women and their families through education, prevention, support and advocacy in the United States and around the world. The \$10,000 from FSC will help SisterLove extend their Reproductive Justice and HIV/AIDS Campaign into South Carolina, Mississippi and Alabama.

SisterSong

of Atlanta, GA is one of the largest national coalitions of women of color in the U.S. working on reproductive justice issues. Their members include approximately 80 local, regional and national grassroots organizations. The \$10,000 awarded will support their National Reproductive Justice Collaborative, Reproductive Justice Training Program, Advocacy Program, and the publication *Collective Voices*.



St. Thomas Presbyterian Church of Houston, TX received \$25,000 through our Donor Advised program. This money will be used to help make much needed improvements to the facility.

Volunteers for Youth of Carrboro, NC received \$2,000 through our Donor Advised program to support their Volunteer Mentor Program. The program consists of youth ages seven to seventeen, who are referred from juvenile court, law enforcement, guidance counselors, teachers, mental health professionals, social workers and parents.
